## 2012 College Awareness Week

Date	Event	Activity
Wednesday, February 15	<b>College Ice Breaker</b>	To begin a college-going culture throughout the campuses, all teachers will prepare for "College Awareness Week" by sharing their educational background. They will talk about their alma mater and collegiate experiences. Teachers will talk with students about their college choices and journey and about careers that are linked to the subjects the students are studying.
Wednesday, February 15	<b>College Financial Aid Parent Night</b>	Department of Guidance and Counseling "50 Million Dollar Scholarship Challenge" Parent Financial Aid Work Session @PLC (6pm)
Tuesday, February 21	<b>College Door Contest</b>	Each classroom can "adopt" a college to represent. This can be the teachers' alma mater or the class may select a university of their choice. Students can decorate their classroom doors in college colors and symbols, create representations of the college mascot, and research the particulars about their college.
Wednesday, February 22	<b>Wall of Fame</b>	Display former students and the college/university that they attended.
Thursday, February 23	<b>Focus on Graduation</b>	Have students contribute to a classroom bulletin board that focuses on graduation. Students might bring a graduation photograph or picture of a family member or friend to display. Images may include graduation from pre-school or kindergarten, high school, college, or training programs. Students may list words, write sentences or write a paragraph explaining why graduations are so important.
Friday, February 24	<b>College Awareness Day</b>	Staff will wear and display college paraphernalia throughout the classroom. They will have conversations with students about the opportunities for college and how to prepare for it.
Saturday, February 25	<b>College Expo</b> @Mundy's Mill High School 10am-12pm	Students and parents will have the opportunity to attend a college fair. They will be able to meet with university representatives to inquire about their admissions process.
Saturday, February 25	<b>Step Show</b> @Mundy's Mill High School	CCPS students will compete for the coveted Superintendent's Winners Cup. Staff members are encouraged to wear college or greek paraphernalia.
