## **Objective:**

1. To enhance community partnerships in a positive manner with an emphasis on increasing positive male involvement through partnership with All-Pro Dads.
2. To promote a healthy sense of competition among participants
3. To encourage safe grilling practices
4. To promote the importance of community and positive male role models in the educational process.

## **Eligibility:**

All entrants must adhere to all challenge rules and regulations to be eligible to win.

## **Rules & Regulations:**

- Contestants will furnish all equipment needed to participate in the contests.
- Contestants are responsible for all ingredients used in the competition (marinades, wood chips, hickory smoke, etc).
- Charcoal and Gas grills may be used and must be provided by contestants.
- Entries must be submitted for judging at 1:30 PM deadline.
- Awards ceremony will begin @ 2:00 PM.
- Entries will be evaluated on tenderness, juiciness, flavor, presentation and originality.
- Contestants must also clean up their station after judging. Charcoal must be disposed of properly:
  - Placed in a metal container provided at the site
  - Soaked in a bucket of water
  - Do not put charcoal in a container with other trash or leave it in the open.

## COMPETITION GUIDELINES

1. During PSMS Tailgate Cook-off Challenge competition, each contestant will supply their own charcoal, gas or pellet grill and racks for grilling.
2. Contestants must bring their own ingredients and dishes for preparation.
3. Each contestant must prepare 2 proteins of any combination of Beef, Chicken, or Pork to be considered for judging
4. Contestants are NOT required to submit a recipe for participation.
5. Scoring will be based on following scale

<b>1<sup>st</sup> Protein – 50 Points</b>		
Taste – 30 Points	Presentation – 15 Points	Originality – 5 Points
<b>2<sup>nd</sup> Protein – 50 Points</b>		
Taste – 30 Points	Presentation – 15 Points	Originality – 5 Points
<b>Peoples Champion – 10 Points</b>		
<b>Total = 110 Points</b>		

6. Grilling contestants must complete entry form and submit by September 24 to be eligible to win. Entry forms may be obtained at Pointe South Middle School. For participation and contest information please contact:

7. Winners will be defined as follows:
  - a. Chicken Master = Best Chicken Entry: Trophy, Title, & Small cash award (based on number of participants)
  - b. Beef Master = Best Beef Entry: Trophy, Title, & Small cash award (based on number of participants)
  - c. Pork Master = Best Pork Entry Trophy, Title, & Small cash award (based on number of participants)
  - d. PSMS Tailgate Cook-off Grilling Champion = Highest Score and competition winner Trophy, Title, & Cash award (based on number of participants)

## COMPETITION RULES

1. Meat – teams will be expected to prepare and present 2 proteins in any combination for judging.
2. Participants are expected to provide tasting samples to competition spectators to be considered for Peoples Champion Points.
3. Participants are responsible for providing a Grilling Source and all Meats and Seasonings.
4. All meats must reach an internal cooking temperature of 145 degrees in order to be accepted.
5. Sanitation – Cooks are to prepare and cook meat in a sanitary manner:
  - a. Contestants must adhere to all local health department codes
  - b. All cooking areas must be maintained in a neat and orderly manner and left as they were found upon arrival, including all trash appropriately tied in bags and placed in containers provided.
6. Boxes will be provided, however contestants may use their own method of presentation for submitting meats to the turn-in table for judging.
7. Entry Fee:
  - a. \$25.00 = Per grilling participant \$5.00 of each entry fee will be added to a prize pool for Cash awards
  - b. Admission
    - i. \$5.00 = Per Adult Spectator for Tasting Plate
    - ii. \$3.00 = Per Child Spectator for tasting Plate
8. All Proceeds from Entries and Admissions will be utilized to support Pointe South Middle School in its improvement Process
